INVESTIGATION LEADS TO AN ARREST REGARDING INDUCING WITNESS & BRIBERY

February 1, 2024- Kankakee, IL – After a lengthy investigation by the Sheriff's Office, 37-year-old, Sharona S Mondy of Pembroke Township, IL, was arrested for Bribery (Class 2 Felony), Obstructing Justice/Induce Witness (Class 4 Felony) and the Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance (Class 4 Felony).

Mondy is alleged to have offered a bribe to a witness in regards to an on-going



case involving her live-in boyfriend in hopes that the witness would recant an official statement made during the initial investigation.
